

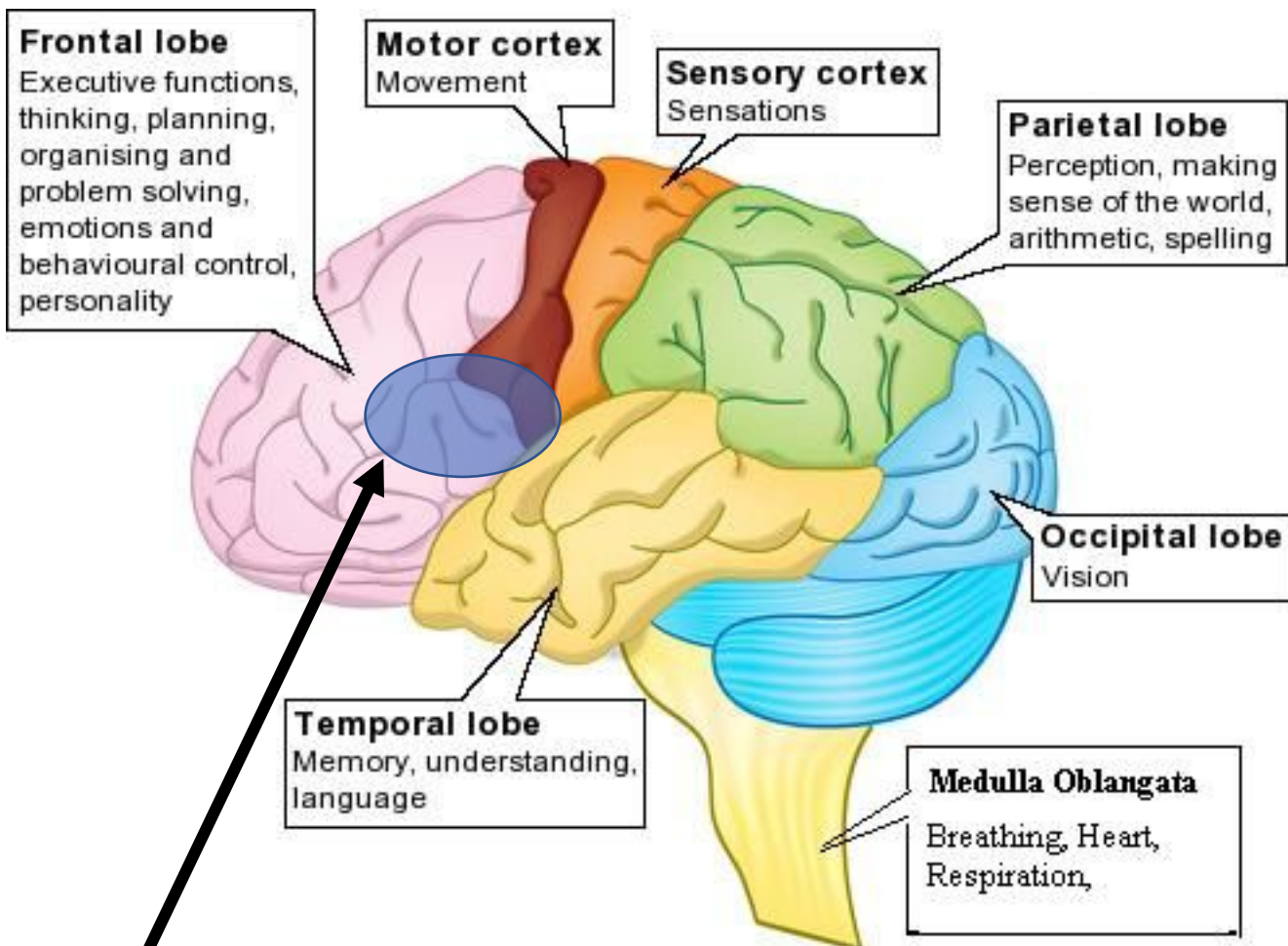
Diagnosis

Stroke = Ischemic Stroke, a blood clot blocks blood from flowing to the brain

Caused by:

High blood pressure

My Stroke- Left Hemisphere



Main Stroke- Frontal Lobe
(Broca's area and the Motor Cortex)

Result of Stroke

Aphasia

- A Language impairment due to a brain injury
- Can affect speech, understanding, reading, and writing

Right-sided hemiparesis

- Reduced ability to move the right-side of your body
- Can affect arm, leg, face, or trunk
- Can affect your ability to walk or grasp items

My Language Broken Down

Aphasia- Broca's Aphasia

My brain has difficulty accessing the network of words needed to speak and repeat fluently but can understand well

Speaking- moderate to severe (Weakness)*

- Fluency- moderate difficulty
- Word Finding- severe difficulty

Comprehension- mild difficulty

- Understanding others- mild

Reading- Strength**

- Comprehension- normal
- Out-loud: mild difficulty

Writing- Moderate difficulty
